The Indian Society for Clinical Research (ISCR) presents a two-day hands-on workshop on the essentials of **Research Manuscript Writing** at Stellar IT Park Business Center, Noida, on **19-20 April 2018**. The sessions will be conducted by experts who have vast experience in publications as writers, editors, and scientific reviewers.

### **Highlights:**

This two-day workshop aims at introducing participants (limited strictly to the first 50 trainees only) to several aspects of publication writing, in compliance with the latest guidelines and policies, and exploring new, enhanced publication possibilities at par with international standards. This workshop discusses the complete life cycle of a manuscript, including sessions on ethical considerations and guidelines for publication, global publication practices, how to perform literature research, selecting a target journal, drafting different sections in a manuscript, submission processes, and responding to reviewers' comments. Our aim is to provide the trainees with hands-on training/exercise/demonstration on different aspects of manuscript development, including, critically appraising different sections in an article. By the end of this 2-day workshop, each trainee should be able to understand the basic structuring and authoring of a scientific manuscript and have fair understanding of the regulations that govern publication writing.
